Application Process

Apply only if you intend to participate once approved. All potential vendors complete an application and receive email notification of approval status. Payment links are sent out monthly and vendors may pay for one date or multiple dates. Payment must be received by noon the Tuesday of market week to be added to the vendor map, which is distributed by 2pm on Wednesday (market day).

Accepted Mediums

Ceramics, Photography, Sculpture, Wood, Stone, Fiber, Mixed Media, Jewelry, Metal, Watercolor, Oils, Acrylic, Bath and Beauty Products, Candles, Printmaking, and Up-cycled/Repurposed Art. Email to discuss other mediums not listed.

Requirements

All work must be original, handmade by the artist/exhibitor. Artists must be present during the entire market period. Mass produced, wholesale, imported items, purchased decals not designed by the artist, and drug paraphernalia are prohibited. Vintage/resale applications are not currently accepted.

Setup & Operations

Setup begins Wednesday at 3pm. Unload near courtyard gates, then move vehicles to the parking lot across Coopers Alley Street (do not use Art Center parking lots). All vendors must complete setup by 5pm. Teardown cannot begin before 8pm.

Booth Requirements

Pop-up tents are required for all vendors unless assigned under courtyard eaves. Business name must be prominently displayed through signage, banners, or printed tablecloths. Tables must be covered with tablecloths. Attractive booth presentation with well-displayed art increases customer engagement.

Documentation

Submit at least 3 high-quality images representing your work (one will be used for event promotion) and include a recent booth setup photo if available. A website, Facebook, or Instagram presence is strongly encouraged and considered during the jury process. ACCC promotes vendors through weekly social media posts about the market.

Fees & Space

Monthly (4 consecutive Wednesdays): \$70.00 | Weekly: \$20.00. Each vendor receives a 10' x 10' space operating as a booth space lease. Vendors must bring all materials, tables, chairs, and products. Weekly spaces are first-come, first-served. All fees are non-refundable and non-transferable except for inclement weather or emergencies when ACCC may offer credit. No booth sharing permitted; each artist requires separate space and application. Vendors must be able to receive and process their own payments for goods and services.

Compliance

Vendors are approved for submitted mediums only. Selling items beyond approved scope requires removal and pre-approval from the Artisan Market committee. The coordinator reserves the right to refuse exhibition of work inconsistent with submitted images, with immediate removal and no refund for non-compliance.

Concerns & Liability

Address immediate concerns with the on-site Market Manager or email artisanmarket@artcenterccc.org for review. Vendors release ACCC and its members from responsibility for injuries or property loss/damage during market participation.
